Revelation 19:11-21 (NASB)

The Coming of Christ

“¹¹ And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on it is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and wages war. ¹² His eyes *are* a flame of fire, and on His head *are* many crowns; and He has a name written *on Him* which no one knows except Himself. ¹³ *He is* clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. ¹⁴ And the armies which are in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white *and* clean, were following Him on white horses. ¹⁵ From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty. ¹⁶ And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written: ‘KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.’

¹⁷ Then I saw an angel standing in the sun, and he cried out with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in midheaven, ‘Come, assemble for the great feast of God, ¹⁸ so that you may eat the flesh of kings and the flesh of commanders, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them, and the flesh of all people, both free and slaves, and small and great.’

¹⁹ And I saw the beast and the kings of the earth and their armies, assembled to make war against Him who sat on the horse, and against His army.

Doom of the Beast and False Prophet

²⁰ And the beast was seized, and with him the false prophet who performed the signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image; these two were thrown alive into the lake of fire, which burns with brimstone. ²¹ And the rest were killed with the sword which came from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse, and all the birds were filled with their flesh.”

Review:

The Marriage of the Lamb: this a promise! **When it states in Revelation 19:9**, "... 'Write: "Blessed are those who are invited to the wedding feast of the Lamb."'" And he *said to me, **'These are the true words of God.'**"

"These are the true words of God" is equal to saying "A Special Promise".

2 Corinthians 1:20 (AMP) – "For as many as are the promises of God, in Christ they are [all answered] **'Yes.'** So through Him we say our "Amen" to the glory of God."

Marriage is Now Solemnized in Heaven

Note: The Bride of Christ has now celebrated and rejoiced over the Bridegroom! The Marriage of the Lamb of God is complete. His Bride is secured and locked into Heaven. It's now time for the Bridegroom to go to War!

Key: You will **only** know it's time for His return **When It's Time...** Selah.

Matthew 24:36-39 (NASB) - "³⁶ But about that day and hour **no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father alone.** ³⁷ For the coming of the Son of Man will be just like the days of Noah. ³⁸ For as in those days before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, ³⁹ and they did not understand until the flood came and took them all away; so will the coming of the Son of Man be."

Verse 11

The Coming of Christ

Revelation 19:11 (NASB) – “And ‘**I saw Heaven opened**’ and behold, a **white horse**, and He who sat on it *is* called **Faithful and True**, and **in righteousness** He judges and wages war.”



White-(Greek)-*leukos*- light, bright, brilliant, of the garments of angels, and of those exalted to the splendour of the heavenly state.

Faithful-(Greek)-*pistos*- of persons who show themselves faithful in the transaction of business, the execution of commands, or the discharge of official duties.

True-(Greek)-*alethinos*-that which has not only the name and resemblance, but the real nature corresponding to the name, in every respect corresponding to the idea signified by the name, real, true, and genuine.

Understanding: This is speaking to His nature of the G-d who keeps His Covenant and His Promises!

Verse 12

“Eyes are a flame of fire”

- Jesus sees ALL; there is nothing that He has missed.
- Jesus is seeing clearly all those He will **judge with a Righteous judgment**.
- Impurities are being removed from the earth.
- His eyes, like fire, shall purify all that He looks upon.

“On His Head are Many Crowns”



Key: “He has a name written on Him which **NO ONE** knows except Himself.”

Matthew 11:27 (NASB) – “All things have been handed over to Me by My Father; and no one knows the Son except the Father; ...”

Verse 13

“Clothed With A Robe Dipped In Blood”

Key: This symbolizes His own blood!

- The price He paid to atone for the sins of the world.
- His mediatorial power.
- The blood of His enemies, over whom He has always won the victory.

“His Name Is Called The Word of God”



John 1:14 (NASB) – “And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us; and we saw His glory, glory as of the only *Son* from the Father, full of grace and truth.”

Flesh-(Greek)-sarx- flesh (the soft substance of the living body, which covers the bones and is permeated with blood) of both man and beasts

Verse 14

“The Armies of Heaven Following Him”



Note: We know that they are clothed in fine linen, white and clean, signifying that these are those who have been cleaned by the Blood of the Lamb and made Righteous in Him.

Verse 15

Revelation 19:15 (NASB) - “From His mouth comes a **sharp sword**, so that **with it** He may strike down the nations,...



“With It”

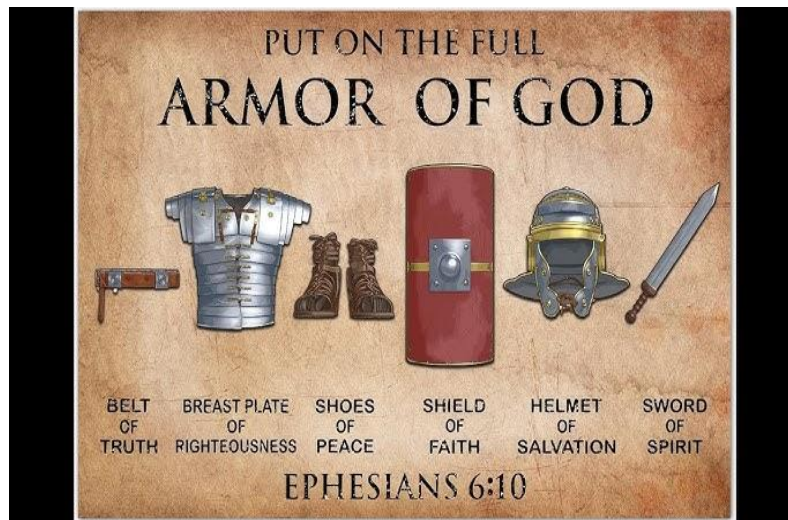
Question: With What?

Answer: A Sharp Sword!

Note: Jesus does not need to lift a hand, He only Speaks the Word of God (TRUTH) in the Battle against darkness (LIES)! This is a Supernatural Fight and the Lord uses The Supernatural Power of the Word of God! This is NOT an emotional response. JUST TRUTH!

John 6:63 (NASB) – “It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh provides no benefit; the words that I have spoken to you are spirit, and are life.”

Ephesians 6:10-17 - The Armor of God



Remember: This armor is a **spiritual** representation.

“Sharp Sword”

Hebrews 4:12 (AMP) - “For the word of God is living and active *and* full of power [making it operative, energizing, and effective]. It is sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating as far as the division of the soul and spirit [the completeness of a person], and of both joints and marrow [the deepest parts of our nature], exposing *and* judging the very thoughts and intentions of the heart.”



Understanding: Two-Edged Sword- A two-edged sword is considered more dangerous than a regular (single-edged) sword because it can cut effectively on both sides of the blade, allowing for more versatile attacks. It can harm the user as easily as the opponent depending on the situation.

Key: The Sword is the Word of G-d! If you can't wield the Sword, put it down! You will cause injury if not handled correctly.

Verse 16

Revelation 19:16 (NASB) – “¹⁶And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written: ‘KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.’”

Key: This is symbolic of Yeshua's supreme authority and power over all rulers, The thigh represents His strength and dominion, essentially portraying Jesus as the ultimate ruler above all other kings and lords.

Verses 17-19



Revelation 19:17-18 (NASB) – “¹⁷ Then I saw an angel standing in the sun, and he cried out with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in midheaven, ‘Come, assemble for the great feast of God, ¹⁸ so that you may eat the flesh of kings and the flesh of commanders, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them, and the flesh of all people, both free and slaves, and small and great.’”

- There will be so much death that the birds are commanded to come and eat.
- The Kings, Commanders, Mighty Men, even their horses and riders (**Verse 19**).
- **ALL** people regardless of status.

Verses 20-21

Doom of the Beast and False Prophet

“The Beast was seized and the False Prophet”



- The False Prophet performed signs by which he deceived those who had received the Mark of the Beast and those who worshiped his image.
- These two were thrown alive into the lake of fire, which burns with brimstone.
- The rest were killed with the sword which came from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse, and all the birds were filled with their flesh.
