### Chapter 8 PT. 2: Jesus Is the Light of the World

### John 8:12-30

#### **Verses 12-13**

**John 8:12-13 (NASB)** – "<sup>12</sup> Then Jesus again spoke to them, saying, '**I am** the Light of the world; the one who follows Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the Light of life.' <sup>13</sup> So the Pharisees said to Him, 'You are testifying about Yourself; Your testimony is not true.'"



Note: Yeshua never fails to let us know that He knows His identity!

- He never shrinks back or stumbles.
- Yeshua found boldness and strength in His identity.
- Knowing the Identity of the G-d you serve creates G-d Confidence in you.

## Father's Introduction to Abraham at 99 Years Old



Genesis 17:1 (NASB) – "¹ Now when Abram was ninety-nine years old, the LORD appeared to Abram and said to him, 'I am God Almighty; Walk before Me, and be blameless."

"El Shaddai" translates to "God Almighty".


# Father's Introduction to Moses at 80 Years Old



**Exodus 3:14 (NASB)** – "<sup>14</sup> And God said to Moses, 'I AM WHO I AM'; and He said, 'This is what you shall say to the sons of Israel: "I AM has sent me to you.""

"I AM WHO I AM" Hebrew interpreted as "I will be what I will be" or "I will manifest Myself as I will manifest Myself," (Expresses the Self-Sufficiency, and the Eternal Existence of G-d and the ability to become whatever He chooses).

### Jesus' 1st Introduction to Mankind: Andrew



**John 1:41 (NASB)** – "<sup>41</sup> He first found his own brother Simon and said to him, 'We have found the Messiah' (which translated means Christ)."

## **Verses 14-16**

John 8:14-16 (NASB) – "<sup>14</sup> Jesus answered and said to them, 'Even if I am testifying about Myself, My testimony is true, because <u>I know where I came from and where I am going</u>; but you do not know where I come from or where I am going. <sup>15</sup> You judge according to the flesh; I am not judging anyone. <sup>16</sup> But even if I do judge, My judgment is true; for I am not alone *in it*, but I and the Father who sent Me."

Understanding: Just as the Father judges in righteousness, so does the Son!

**Revelation 16:7 (NASB)** – "<sup>7</sup> And I heard the altar saying, 'Yes, Lord God, the Almighty, true and righteous are Your judgments."

#### **Verses 17-18**

**John 8:17-18 (NASB)** – "<sup>17</sup> Even in <u>your Law</u> it has been written that the testimony of two people is true. <sup>18</sup> I am He who testifies about Myself, and the Father who sent Me testifies about Me."

#### Where is It Written?

**Deuteronomy 17:6 (NASB)** – "<sup>6</sup> On the testimony of two witnesses or three witnesses, the condemned shall be put to death; he shall not be put to death on the testimony of *only* one witness."

**Note:** Jesus states, "your Law" because they have taken the Law and made it fit them! For the Religious Leaders, the Law is used to control and **not** something to live by.

#### **Verses 18-20**

John 8:18-20 (NASB) – "<sup>18</sup> 'I am He who testifies about Myself, and the Father who sent Me testifies about Me.' <sup>19</sup> So they were saying to Him, 'Where is Your Father?' Jesus answered, 'You know neither Me nor My Father; if you knew Me, you would know My Father also.' <sup>20</sup> These words He spoke in the treasury, as He taught in the temple *area*; and no one arrested Him, because His hour had not yet come."

**Remember:** You cannot know the Son unless the Father is involved! You did not come to the Lord for Salvation; you were drawn to Him!

**John 6:44 (AMP)** – "<sup>44</sup> No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him [giving him the desire to come to Me]; …"

## **Verses 21-22**

**John 8:21-22 (NASB)** – "<sup>21</sup> Then He said again to them, 'I am going away, and you will look for Me, and **will die in your sin**; where I am going, you cannot come.' <sup>22</sup> So the Jews were saying, 'Surely He will not kill Himself, will He, since He says, "Where I am going, you cannot come"?""



**Note:** It's an awful thing for Jesus to tell you you're going to hell and you do not know it! But Jesus still extends His Grace to all, even these.

#### **Verses 23-24**

**John 8:23-24 (NASB)** – "<sup>23</sup> And He was saying to them, 'You are from below, I am from above; you are of this world, I am not of this world. <sup>24</sup> Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for <u>unless</u> you believe that I am, you will die in your sins."

**Key:** Jesus can say this about everyone post the Garden of Eden! Why?

Romans 3:23 (AMP) – "<sup>23</sup> since all have sinned and *continually* fall short of the glory of God, ..."

**Question:** What makes anyone any different than the Pharisees and Sadducees (Religious Leaders)?

**Answer:** We were drawn to Jesus by the Father; we have been given the great privilege to know Jesus and to be known by Jesus!

## Verses 25

John 8:25 (NASB) – "25 Then they were saying to Him, 'Who are You?' Jesus said to them, 'What have I even been saying to you from the beginning?"

**Note:** It is not a sin to ask a question. Jesus had human emotions and human responses. The difference is when Jesus asks a question, He already knows the answer.

### **Verses 26-27**

**John 8:26-27 (NASB)** – "<sup>26</sup> 'I have many things to say and to judge regarding you, but He who sent Me is true; and the things which I heard from Him, these I say to the world.' <sup>27</sup> They did not realize that He was speaking to them *about* the Father."

**Key:** One day all will know that Jesus never speaks unless it is from the Father and pleased the Father. We all should follow such a great example of disciplining our tongues. To not follow it will bring judgement.

**Matthew 12:36-37 (AMP)** – "<sup>36</sup> But I tell you, on the day of judgment people will have to give an accounting for every careless *or* useless word they speak. <sup>37</sup> For by your words [reflecting your spiritual condition] you will be justified *and* acquitted of the guilt of sin; and by your words [**rejecting Me**] you will be condemned *and* sentenced."



# **Guard Against Words Of:**

- Fear
- Doubt
- Unbelief

## <u>Verses 28-30</u>

**John 8:28-30 (NASB)** – "<sup>28</sup> So Jesus said, 'When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am, and I do nothing on My own, but I say these things as the Father instructed Me. <sup>29</sup> And He who sent Me is with Me; He has not left Me alone, for I always do the things that are pleasing to Him.' <sup>30</sup> As He said these things, many came to believe in Him."

**Key:** While Jesus is giving the testimony concerning Himself and His relationship with His Father, Salvation came to many!

- Your witness (of Jesus being lifted up on the cross) that has given you the right to be called a son of God, will have the same impact to those around you!
- Salvation comes through your witness.
