Study Notes
Chapter 11 PT. 2: The Seventh Trumpet

Revelation 11:13-19 (NASB) – “¹³ And at that time there was a great earthquake, and a tenth of the city fell; seven thousand people were killed in the earthquake, and the rest were terrified and gave glory to the God of heaven.

¹⁴ The second woe has passed; behold, the third woe is coming quickly.

¹⁵ Then the seventh angel sounded; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying,

‘The kingdom of the world has become *the kingdom* of our Lord and of His Christ; and He will reign forever and ever.’ ¹⁶ And the twenty-four elders, who sit on their thrones before God, fell on their faces and worshiped God, ¹⁷ saying,

‘We give You thanks, Lord God, the Almighty, the One who is and who was, because You have taken Your great power and have begun to reign. ¹⁸ And the nations were enraged, and Your wrath came, and the time *came* for the dead to be judged, and *the time* to reward Your bond-servants the prophets and the saints and those who fear Your name, the small and the great, and to destroy those who destroy the earth.’

¹⁹ And the temple of God which is in heaven was opened; and the ark of His covenant appeared in His temple, and there were flashes of lightning and sounds and peals of thunder, and an earthquake, and a great hailstorm.”

Review:

- After being dead for 3 ½ days, the two Witnesses/Prophets have come back to life for all the world to see.
- They came with all the power of the effectiveness of the witness of the Church in the earth.

- They ascended up into Heaven; the voice saying, “Come Up Here”.
- Father made sure it happened right in front of their enemies’ eyes.



Verse 13

Revelation 11:13 (NASB) – “And at that time there was a great earthquake, and a tenth of the city fell; seven thousand people were killed in the earthquake, and the rest were terrified and gave glory to the God of heaven.”

Note: As soon as the Two Witnesses ascend from the earth, then the earth opens.



- Seven thousand people are swallowed.

- Those who stood around and mocked the Two Prophets were immediately and completely judged.
- The rest now understand who they are really dealing with.
- The rest knew to repent and worship the Righteous Judge.
- Many Jews will be saved because of this terrifying event.

Verse 14

Revelation 11:14 (NASB) – “The second woe has passed; behold, the third woe is coming quickly.”

Note: This is in reference to **Revelation 8:13**.

Revelation 8:13 (NASB) – “Then I looked, and I heard an eagle flying in midheaven, saying with a loud voice, ‘**Woe, woe, woe** to those who live on the earth, because of the remaining blasts of the trumpet of the three angels who are about to sound!’”

Understanding: The fifth, sixth and seventh trumpets are called the “Three Woes”

- **Woe 1: THE FIFTH TRUMPET** - A plague of locusts from the abyss that torments unbelievers for five months.



- **Woe 2: THE SIXTH TRUMPET** - A massacre by demonic 200-Million-man army that kills one third of mankind.



Note: The first two “Woes” are in Chapter 9, the third “Woe” is about to be released by. This is a warning and demand for John to pay attention.

- **Woe 3: THE SEVENTH TRUMPET** - The rise of Satan's two henchmen, the beast and the false prophet, and the announcement of God's Kingdom.

The Seventh Trumpet: Christ’s Reign Foreseen



Verse 15

Revelation 11:15 (NASB) – “Then the seventh angel sounded; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, ‘The kingdom of the world has become *the kingdom* of our Lord and of His Christ; and He will reign forever and ever.’”

Understanding: Just like in **Revelation 8:1**, when the Seventh Seal was opened, it released the Seven Trumpets. So, we have it here in **Revelation 11:15**. When the seventh Trumpet sounds, it releases the Seven Bowls of Wrath.



Revelation 10:7 (NASB) – “but in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he is about to sound, *then the mystery of God is finished*, as He announced to His servants the prophets.”

- God’s mystery will be fulfilled.
- God’s perfect timing for all things to come to an end has arrived.
- Everything on earth has now reached its appointed conclusion.
- By the end of this Seventh Trumpet, the fulfillment of every word the Prophets spoke shall be finished.

Verse 16

Revelation 11:16 (NASB) – “And the twenty-four elders, who sit on their thrones before God, fell on their faces and worshiped God,”



- They bow down because the victory belongs to Jesus.
- They take a posture of absolute humility and worship on their faces.
- Yeshua takes control of the earth back from the enemy.
- They worship the One who keeps His Word.

Verse 17

Revelation 11:17 (NASB) - “We give You thanks, Lord God, the Almighty, the One who is and who was, because You have taken Your great power and have begun to reign.”

- This is the fulfillment of the Lord’s Prayer: “Thy Kingdom Come’.

Matthew 6:10 (KJV) – “Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.”



Verse 18

Revelation 11:18 (NASB) – “And the nations were enraged, and Your wrath came, and the time *came* for the dead to be judged, and *the time* to reward Your bond-servants the prophets and the saints and those who fear Your name, the small and the great, and to destroy those who destroy the earth.”

Note: This is foretold in **Psalms 2**. The Messianic Prophecy of the Anointed One.

Psalms 2:1-8 (NASB) – “¹Why are the nations restless

And the peoples plotting in vain?

² The kings of the earth take their stand

And the rulers conspire together

Against the LORD and against His Anointed, *saying*,

³ ‘Let’s tear their shackles apart

And throw their ropes away from us!’

⁴ He who sits in the heavens laughs,

The Lord scoffs at them.

⁵ Then He will speak to them in His anger

And terrify them in His fury, *saying*,

⁶ ‘But as for Me, I have installed My King

Upon Zion, My holy mountain.’

⁷ ‘I will announce the decree of the LORD:

He said to Me, “You are My Son,

Today I have fathered You.

⁸ Ask *it* of Me, and I will certainly give the nations as Your inheritance,

And the ends of the earth as Your possession.”””

➤ He keeps His Word! He does what He said He will!

Verse 19

Revelation 11: 19 (NASB) – “ And the temple of God which is in heaven was opened; and the ark of His covenant appeared in His temple, and there were flashes of lightning and sounds and peals of thunder, and an earthquake, and a great hailstorm.”



Key: John was allowed to see the Ark of the Covenant and its contents: the Tablets of the Law. This is an announcement from God that “I am returning My Word to the earth. It’s coming back!”, for in this day the Word will be gone from the earth. The Word will be rejected and true believers will have gone through intense persecution.

HAVE HOPE, REMNANT!

The Word WILL be restored in the earth and the enemy WILL give up His throne, for God HIMSELF will put Jesus on the Mount of Olives to rule and reign until the time is at an end for the enemy. And a New Heaven and a New Earth will be ushered in, where there will be no more tears, no more persecution, and The Word WILL REMAIN FOREVER!
