Chapter 11 PT. 1: The Two Witness of God

Revelation 11:1-12 (NASB) – "¹ Then there was given to me a measuring rod like a staff; and someone said, 'Get up and measure the temple of God and the altar, and those who worship in it. ² Leave out the courtyard which is outside the temple and do not measure it, because it has been given to the nations; and they will trample the holy city for forty-two months. ³ And I will grant *authority* to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy for 1,260 days, clothed in sackcloth.' ⁴ These are the two olive trees and the two lampstands that stand before the Lord of the earth. ⁵ And if anyone wants to harm them, fire flows out of their mouth and devours their enemies; and *so* if anyone wants to harm them, he must be killed in this way. ⁶ These have the power to shut up the sky, so that rain will not fall during the days of their prophesying; and they have power over the waters to turn them into blood, and to strike the earth with every plague, as often as they desire.

⁷ When they have finished their testimony, the beast that comes up out of the abyss will make war with them, and overcome them and kill them. ⁸ And their dead bodies *will lie* on the street of the great city which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also their Lord was crucified. ⁹ Those from the peoples, tribes, languages, and nations *will* look at their dead bodies for three and a half days, and will not allow their dead bodies to be laid in a tomb. ¹⁰ And those who live on the earth *will* rejoice over them and celebrate; and they will send gifts to one another, because these two prophets tormented those who live on the earth.

¹¹ And after the three and a half days, the breath of life from God came into them, and they stood on their feet; and great fear fell upon those who were watching them. ¹² And they heard a loud voice from heaven saying to them, 'Come up here.' And they went up into heaven in the cloud, and their enemies watched them."

Understanding: Now John has taken the book from the hand of the angel and was told in **Revelation 10:11**, that "thou must prophesy again". Now, in **Revelation 11:1-2**, this same angel is giving John new instructions.

- The Church is gone.
- The Anti-Christ is revealed.
- This is during the 1^{st} $3^{1/2}$ years of the final week The Great Tribulation!




Verses 1-2

Key: John is given a rod to measure.

- The Temple of God The preservation of the Temple In the Earth- Israel at the time of the Tribulation.
- The Altar The heart of Israel is being measured in the Tribulation time.
- "Them that worship in it" These are **not** true believers. Remember, the true believers have already run to the mountains.

Understanding: This is believed to be referencing the same thing in Ezekiel's vision in Ezekiel 40:3.



Ezekiel 40:3 (NASB) – "So He brought me there; and behold, there was a man whose appearance was like the appearance of bronze, with a thread of flax and a measuring rod in his hand; and he was standing in the gateway."

- The end of book of Ezekiel is like Revelation 11:1-2.
- Ezekiel is taken to a high mountain from which he can observe events in Jerusalem.
- He meets an angel (a man with the appearance of bronze) with a measuring rod in his hands.
- After the measuring is complete, the glory of the Lord returns to the temple.

Verse 2

"Leave Out The Courtyard"

- This was a measurement of the Holy of Holies of the Tribulation temple, not the outer courtyard.
- God is measuring out the things pertaining to the **Jews**, not Gentiles.
- The outer courtyard was the court of the Gentiles.
- God's focus is now the Jews, not the Gentiles.

Verse 3



Revelation 11: 3-4 (NASB) – "³ 'And I will grant *authority* to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy **for 1,260 days, clothed in sackcloth**." ⁴ These are the two olive trees and the two lampstands that stand before the Lord of the earth."

- Scripture does not say who they are.
- Most Theologians believe them to be:
 - o **Moses and Elijah** because they appeared during the transfiguration of Jesus.

OR

 Enoch and Elijah - because they are the only two people in the Scriptures who did not die as required.

Granted Authority:

- The are given authority to speak for God as Prophets.
- They are now Gods mouthpieces to the Jews in the Tribulation.
- They are here to bring warning to the Jews.

One Thousand, Two Hundred & Sixty (1,260) Days:

Note: This is the time in Revelation referred to in three different ways.

• Three and a half years.

- 42 months.
- 1,260 days.

Note: They are all the same, also known as "a time and times and half a time"

Understanding: "time" is a year, and "times" is thus two years. "Half a time," then, is half a year. So, added together, they are $3\frac{1}{2}$ years. Half of the Seven Year Tribulation Time. This is the beginning $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

Sackcloth and Ashes



Biblical Meaning:

- Mourning
- Repentance
- Humility before God

Understanding: Here it represents the humility of the wearer. This is why it is believed that they are not identified. They are representing God, not themselves.

Verse 4

"Two Olive Trees" and "Two Lampstands that Stand Before the Lord"

Note: The prophet Zachariah gets an introduction to these two witnesses in his own vision of a "Golden Lampstand and Olive Trees" (**Zechariah 4**).



Zechariah 4:14 (NASB) – "Then he said, 'These are the two anointed ones, who are standing by the Lord of the whole earth.""

- These two prophets rank very high to God.
- Olive oil was used in the Old Testament times to fuel the Lampstands.
- The Lampstands represent truth; The Oil is the Anointing of God.
- They are both the Fuel of Truth and the Source of Truth.
- They are the Fire of Holy Spirit.
- They are the fullness of the Witness of the Church that is now removed (Revelation 1:20).

Verse 5

Revelation 11:5 (NASB) - "And if anyone wants to harm them, fire flows out of their mouth and devours their enemies; and *so* if anyone wants to harm them, he must be killed in this way."



Verse 6

They Have Unlimited Authority and Power

- These have the power to shut up the sky, so that rain will not fall during the days of their prophesying.
 - \circ What Prophet did this? Answer: Elijah for $3^{1}/_{2}$ years.
- They have power over the waters to turn them into blood, and to strike the earth with every plague, as often as they desire.
 - What Prophet did this? Answer: Moses.

Verses 7-8

Note: Eventually, they are allowed to be killed, but not until they have finished witnessing.

Revelation 11:7-8 (NASB) - "⁷ When they have finished their testimony, the beast that comes up out of the abyss will make war with them, and overcome them and kill them. ⁸ And their dead bodies *will lie* on the street of the great city which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also their Lord was crucified."

- Jerusalem one day will be referred to as Sodom Due to their immorality.
- Jerusalem one day will be referred to as Egypt Due to their lust for material things.

Note: This is why a New Jerusalem, New Heaven and a New Earth is **required!**

Verses 9-10

"A Demonic Celebration"

Note: Nothing torments the devil and his people more than a Believer's Witness! They are savoring the death of the two witnesses.

- Those from the peoples, tribes, languages, and nations *will* look at their dead bodies for three and a half days.
- They will not allow their dead bodies to be laid in a tomb.
- Those who live on the earth *will* rejoice over them and celebrate, and they will send gifts to one another.

• WHY? Because the two prophets tormented those who live on the earth with their witness.

Verses 11-12

The Excitement Does Not Last!



Revelation 11:11-12 (NASB) – "¹¹ And after the three and a half days, the breath of life from God came into them, and they stood on their feet; and great fear fell upon those who were watching them. ¹² And they heard a loud voice from heaven saying to them, 'Come up here.' And they went up into heaven in the cloud, and their enemies watched them."

Key: Where did we hear the command "Come up here" previously?

- Revelation 4:1 (NASB) "¹ After these things I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven, and the first voice which I had heard, like the sound of a trumpet speaking with me, said, 'Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after these things."
 - Father did it for Jesus, and then for John. He will soon do it for us, too!
