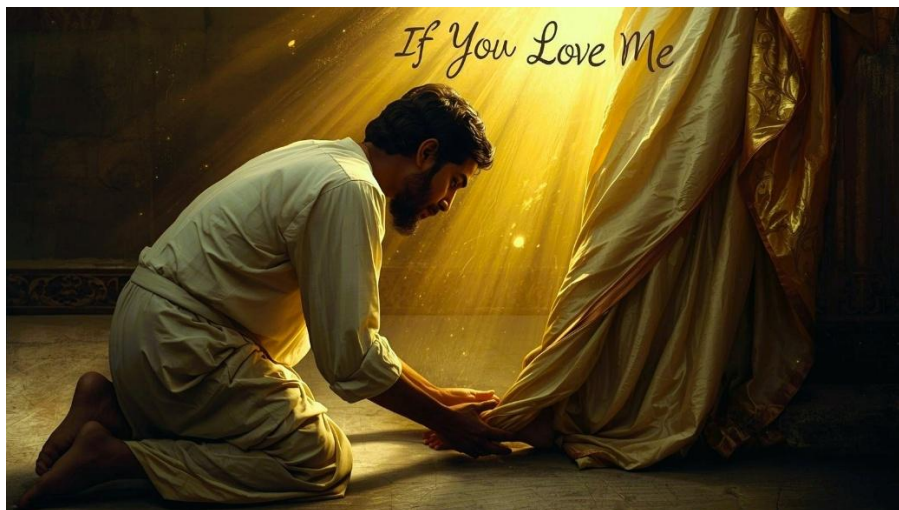


**The Book of John:**  
**The Disciple Jesus Loved**  
**Study Notes**  
**Chapter 14 PT. 2: The Helper**

**John 14:16-31**

**Introduction:** We pick up in **Chapter 14**, where Verse 15 has set a standard. A Command was given and it was directed to those that say they “**Love Him**”!



**Understanding:** Do you realize that it is in only one passage where Jesus sets this precedent?

**John 14:15 (NASB)** – <sup>15</sup> “**If you love Me**, you will keep My commandments”.

**Key:** Even in **John 21:15-17**, Peter was asked 3 times, “**Do you love Me?**”.

- It is implied that Jesus is making a reply based upon this answer.
- Jesus said to Peter (paraphrased), “**Ok then, Tend My sheep**”.
- Jesus is teaching that Love for Him translates into action for Him!

**Verses 16-17**

**John 14:16-17 (NASB)** - <sup>16</sup> I will ask the Father, and He will give you another **Helper**, so that **He** may be with you forever; <sup>17</sup> *the Helper is the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it does not see **Him** or know **Him**; but you know **Him** because **He** remains with you and will be in you.*

## In ALL Your Getting, GET Understanding (Proverbs 4:7)

**Helper-(Greek-NASB)-*paraklētos***-meaning, "one called alongside to help," often referring to an advocate, comforter, or counselor.

**Comforter-(Greek-KJV)- *paraklētos***-meaning, summoned, called to one's side, especially called to one's aid; hence:

- One who pleads another's cause before a judge.
- Counsel of defense.
- An Intercessor.



## Doctrine of Justification (Read All - Romans 3:23-28)

**Key:** If you are saved, you are found “Not Guilty”; when it comes to your sins! But you still will be judged on what you did with the “Not Guilty”!

### Verse 18

**John 14:18 (NASB) - <sup>18</sup>** “I will not leave you as orphans; I am coming to you.

**Orphans-(Greek)-*orphanos***-meaning fatherless, parentless, or bereaved

**Comfortless-KJV-(Greek)-*orphanos***-of uncertain affinity; bereaved ("orphan"), i.e. parentless: —comfortless, fatherless. of those bereft of a teacher, guide, guardian

## Verse 19-20

**John 14: 19-20 (NASB)** – <sup>19</sup> After a little while, the world no longer *is going to* see Me, but you *are going to* see Me; because I live, you also will live. <sup>20</sup> **On that day** you will know **that I am in My Father, and you are in Me, and I in you.**

**Note:** After Jesus died and rose again, He showed Himself to the Disciples.

- **Mary Magdalene:** The first to see him in **Matthew 28** and **John 20**.



- **The Women at the Tomb:** Other Women at the tomb. Mary the mother of James, Joanna, Salome, and others encountered Him.
- **Simon Peter (Cephas):** Appeared to him specifically; mentioned in **Luke 24:34** and **1 Corinthians 15:5**.
- **Two Disciples on the Road to Emmaus:** Cleopas and another disciple did not recognize Him immediately.
- **The Apostles:** Appeared to them in the upper room (**without Thomas, then with him**).
- **Over 500 Brethren:** Paul states in **1 Corinthians 15:6** that He appeared to more than **500 followers** at once.

- **James**: Jesus appeared to His brother, James, as noted in **1 Corinthians 15:7**.
- **The Eleven**: The final commissioning on the Mount of Olives, just before the Ascension.



### **Verse 21**

**John 14:21 (NASB) - <sup>21</sup>** The one **who has** My commandments **and keeps them is the one who loves Me**; and the one who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and will reveal Myself to him.”

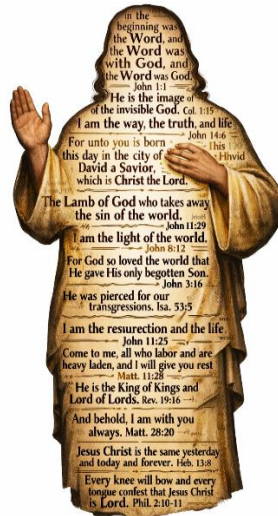
### **WHAT A PROMISE!**

**Understanding:** Jesus just told us why He appeared after the resurrection and did not just go straight back to the Father...He keeps His Promises to those who love Him!

### **Verse 22-24**

**John 14:22-24 (NASB) - <sup>22</sup>** Judas (not Iscariot) said to Him, “Lord, what has happened that You are going to reveal Yourself to us and not to the world?” <sup>23</sup> Jesus answered and said to him, “If anyone loves Me, **he will follow My word**; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make *Our* dwelling with him. <sup>24</sup> The one who does not love Me does not follow My words; and the word which you hear is not Mine, but the Father’s who sent Me.

**Key:** You cannot separate Jesus from the Word!



**John 1:1 (NASB)** – <sup>1</sup>In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

### Verse 25-26

#### **The Helper Identified**

**John 14:25-26 (NASB)** – <sup>25</sup>“These things I have spoken to you while remaining with you. <sup>26</sup>But **the Helper, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send** in My name, He will teach you all things, and remind you of all that I said to you.

**John 14:26 (KJV)** – <sup>26</sup>But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost...



**Key:** He is a Person! **Ruach HaKodesh**,

- Literally means "Spirit of Holiness" or "Holy Spirit".
- It refers to the divine spirit, breath, or wind of G-d.
- **Ruach** (רוּחַ) means spirit/wind/breath, and **Ha Kodesh** (הַקֹּדֶשׁ) means "the holy".
- He is not a dove!
- He is not flames!
- These are ways in which He manifests in the natural realm.
- He IS The Teacher!

### **Verses 27-28**

**John 14:27-28 (NASB)** – <sup>27</sup> Peace I leave you, My peace I give you; not as the world gives, do I give to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled, nor fearful. <sup>28</sup> You heard that I said to you, ‘I am going away, and I am coming to you.’ If you loved Me, you would have rejoiced because **I am going to the Father**, for the Father is greater than I.

**Note:** Jesus is speaking of His advancement and our advantage!



- Yeshua now can leave the limitations of the flesh and walk again as King of Kings and Lord of Lords.
- Because He is Risen, we have been put in the greatest advantage over all that comes against us.

### Verses 29-31

**John 14:29-31 (NASB)** - <sup>29</sup> And now I have told you before it happens, so that when it happens, you may believe. <sup>30</sup> I will not speak much more with you, **for the ruler of the world is coming, and he has nothing in regard to Me,** <sup>31</sup> but so that the world may know that I love the Father, **I do exactly as the Father commanded Me.** Get up, let's go from here.

**Key:** Jesus is our only example of an obedient child! If we love Him, we too must do exactly what He said! Selah
